Being a specialist in communication disorders his main focus is phonosurgery and conservative treatment of patients with voice disorders, especially professional voice users. Another specialization is hearing and speech rehabilitation of patients with cochlear implants.

Prof. Nawka's main interest is the voice in diagnostics and therapy. Over the course of his career, he has developed and refined surgical techniques in phonosurgery. Together with the European Academy of Phoniatics, he is committed to harmonizing this training throughout Europe. 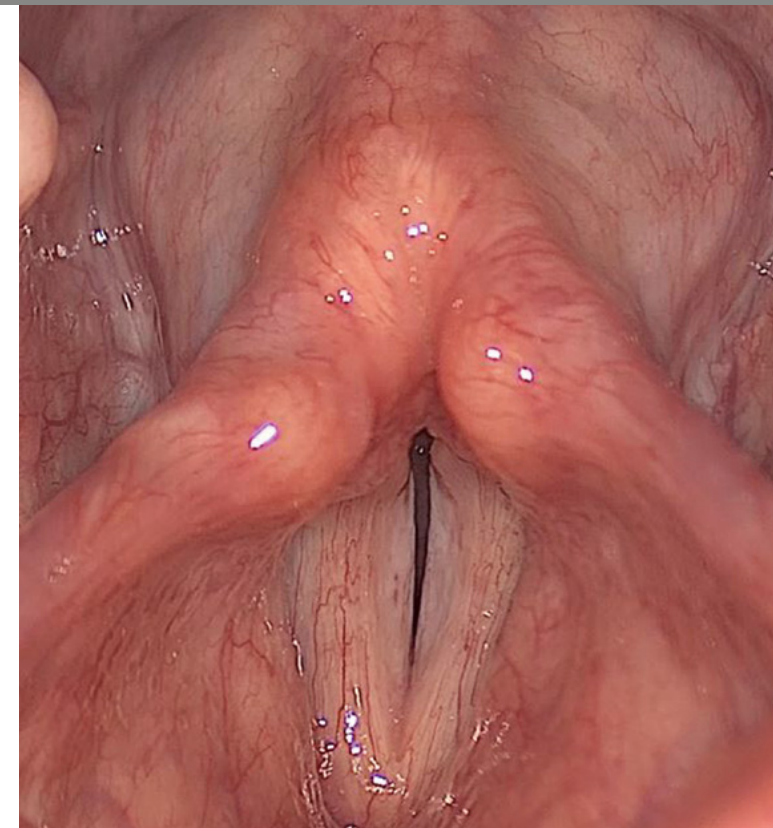
