His main focus is highly specialized Phonomicrosurgery and Laryngeal framework surgery. Further, he is specialized in the voice care of professional singers and actors being himself a graduate of the University of Music Dresden with an artistic diploma. He holds leadership positions in numerous highly recognised medical societies, including currently as Past-President of the German Society of Phoniatics and Pediatric Audiology, Vice-President of the Union of the European Phoniaticians, and Secretary General of the Pan-European Voice Conferences. For many years he has been working as Head of the Voice Research Laboratory at the University of Music Dresden and Lecturer at the University Mozarteum Salzburg.

Prof. Nawka's main interest is the voice in diagnostics and therapy. Over the course of his career, he has developed and refined surgical techniques in phonosurgery. Together with the European Academy of Phoniatics, he is committed to harmonizing this training throughout Europe. 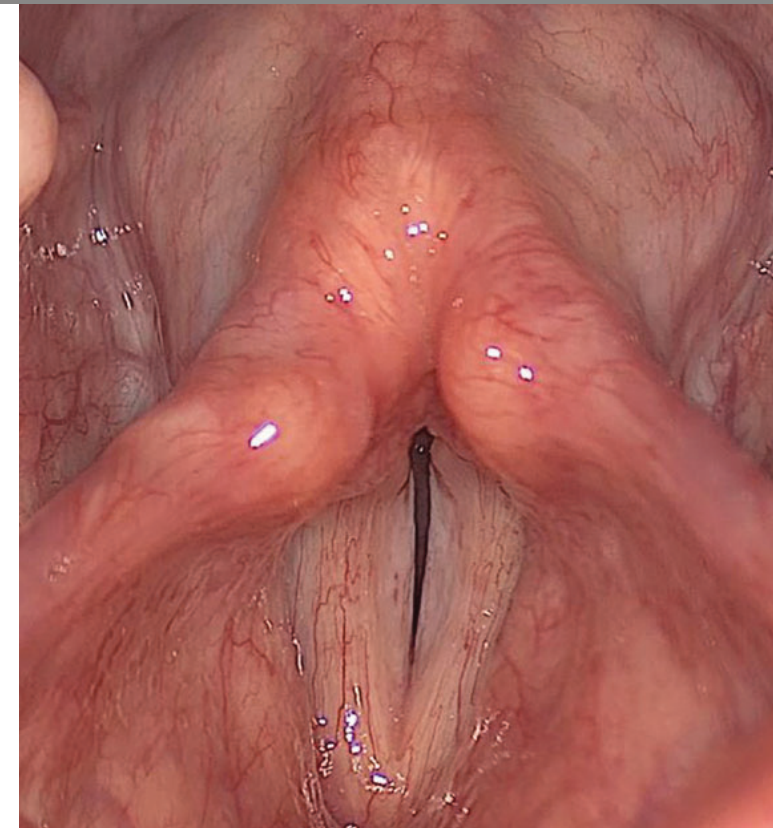
