Prof. Mürbe is Professor for Audology and Phoniatics and head of the Department of Audiology and Phoniatics at the Charité – Universitätsmedizin Berlin. He studied medicine at the Universities of Rostock, Dublin and Dresden and graduated at the same time in vocal studies at the Dresden University of Music with an artistic diploma. Being a specialist in communication disorders his main focus is phonosurgery and conservative treatment of patients with voice disorders, especially professional voice users. Another specialization is hearing and speech rehabilitation of patients with cochlear implants.
